SECTION 2: HAZARD IDENTIFICATION

EMERGENCY OVERVIEW

CAUTION: This product is a clear liquid with a pleasant odor. Direct contact with eyes may cause irritation, with possibility of corneal injury if not removed promptly. SECTION 4: FIRST AID MEASURES

EYES: Immediately rinse eyes with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes, occasionally lifting upper and lower lids, until no evidence of product remains. Get medical attention if pain or irritation persist.
